### THIS COURSE WILL TEACH YOU TO:

- Use lighting and shooting techniques;
- Organize the elements of the image composition;
- Choose the appropriate material for indoor and outdoor photography;
- Retouch photos with Photoshop (introduction);
- Develop a critical sense.

### THIS COURSE IS FOR YOU IF:

- You want to master the basics of photography and its different tools (i.e. camera, computer, mobile device, digital tablet).
- You want to learn lighting techniques and use them in various projects.
- You want to understand the digital workflow and gain working knowledge of various photo retouching software such as Adobe Lightroom and Photoshop.

### COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- To allow you to understand how to take good photos in a variety of situations;
- To take a series of photos in order to participate in a photo exhibit.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Cover letter

### PROGRAM LENGTH:

- A total of 90 hours of training during 15 weeks, 2 evenings per week.

### CLASS SIZE:

Maximum of 12 students per group.

### CERTIFICATION:

Certificate from Inter-Dec College testifying that you participated in the course.
